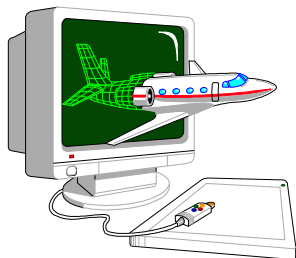
New Frontiers Policies & Procedures

Welcome back to our returning members, and a big welcome to all new members. Again this year you can expect to continue to receive the latest and greatest information about New Frontiers and MCC via the bi-monthly NEWSLETTER, and via private email from our hugely successful INFOLIST. We've made one significant change this year. We are including phone numbers in both the NEWSLETTER and INFOLIST.

The NEWSLETTER is produced FIVE TIMES a year by our editor, Chris Dugandzic and is posted on our web site www.newfrontiers-mesa.org. All members with email addresses will be sent an email via the INFOLIST with a link to the current edition of the NEWSLETTER. Members with no email address will be sent a hard copy of the NEWSLETTER.

The most current way to find out what's happening is from our private email INFOLIST. You can expect to receive information on your computer only about New Frontiers members, New Frontiers activities and events, and MCC Events open to MCC Members. And you will get it first! Could be weekly, or even sometimes on a daily basis. To ensure your privacy, the only personal contact information about you, or any of our members, will be name and contact phone number in the INFOLIST email messages. Rose Frankfort continues to be our INFOLIST Gatekeeper. She makes sure you won't get any emails selling used cars, nor solicitations for garage sales, or donation requests. The INFOLIST is strictly for information of interest to New Frontiers members

To be sure you receive these INFOLIST emails, you need to do two things.

- Give your email address to our Membership committee. They keep the roster up to date.
- Be sure and set your email server to allow messages from communications@newfrontiersraz.org.
